Arthur Siegel Memorial Award

This monetary award (approximately \$500) has been established by the family and friends of Professor Arthur Siegel, a former Communication Studies scholar and teacher at York University, to provide an award to a deserving upper-year Communication Studies student (who has completed at least 60 credits), is a double-major in a program in Social Science, and who has the highest cumulative grade point average among the qualified candidates. The recipient must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person, and an Ontario resident who demonstrates financial need. (If there are no qualified double-majors, then the recipient will be a Communication Studies major.)

The award will be presented at the Awards Ceremony on November 22, 2016.
